REGULATIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE 2019 CSMX MOTORCYCLE ENDURO CLOSED CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP (161808/144)

Note: *These regulations are to be read in conjunction with the General Competition Rules (GCR's), Standing Supplementary Regulations (SSR's), WC Regional Enduro Regulations (161707/144) and any Applicable Circulars of Motorsport South Africa for Enduro. In the event that there is any conflict between club, regional and national rules, the national rules shall, at all times prevail.*

1. CONTROLLERS

CSMX Club Committee.

2. AMENDMENTS

The Controllers reserve the right, without notification, to introduce new Regulations and/or amend existing Regulations. Any such amendment / addition to the regulations shall, however, only come into effect once it has been published in an official MSA circular / bulletin. Changes to these Regulations **shall** be issued at least SEVEN (7) days prior to the next event being held.

3. ELIGIBILITY OF COMPETITORS

- 3.1 The Club Championship shall ONLY be open to CMSX Club Members and only from date of membership. No points scored during the racing year prior to becoming a member will count towards the club championship.
- 3.2 All Competitors must hold current MSA competition licences valid for the event and this must be produced at documentation.

4. AIM OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

The CSMX Club Committee at it's sole discretion shall declare the winners of the 2019 club Championship in the following classes. The Committee is entitled to withhold such declaration, should circumstances warrant such action:

- 4.1 E1/200cc class
Motorcycles up to 125 - 201cc 2-stroke / 150 - 250cc 4-stroke
Open to riders from the year of their 16th birthday and older
- 4.2 E2/Open class
Motorcycles above 201cc two stroke and four-stroke over 251cc
Open to riders from the year of their 18th birthday and older
- 4.3 Senior class
Unrestricted capacity
From year of 36th birthday

- 4.4 Masters class
Unrestricted capacity
From year of 46th birthday
- 4.5 Silver Class
Restricted capacity as per 200cc class.
Open – From the year of their 16th birthday (open to riders who have not finished in the top ten overall for any preceding year or at discretion of the controllers.)
- 4.6 Junior Class
Maximum capacity motorcycle of 125cc.
From the Year of their 15th birthday to year of their 18th birthday – 2 HRS
- 4.7 Ladies class
Restricted capacity and ages as per 200cc and Open Class – 2HRS
- 4.8 Social class
Restricted capacity and ages as per 200cc and Open Class – 2HRS
The winner of the club social class will need to move to the 3hr Silver class or Gold Classes the following year.

6. CLASSES WINNERS AWARDS

MINIMUM OF 3 COMPETITORS PER CLASS TO ANNOUNCE CLASS WINNERS:

IF LESS THAN 3 ON AVERAGE ARE RECEIVED, WE WILL NOT AWARD A CHAMPION

7. ASSISTANCE RENDERED

When a competitor has, with the approval of the organisers, assisted with the organisation/planning of the event, the penalty of exclusion will not apply. A record of the names of the competitors who have “officially” assisted will be kept by the club.
