MCGREGOR ENDURO

WC/CSMX ENDURO CHAMPIONSHIPS & LADIES INTRO

ROUND 1 WC CHAMPS MARCH 16TH



Round 1 of the WC & the CSMX KTM Cape Town Enduro Championship returns to McGregor for the 2019 season opener.

Koeniesriver Farm, owned by Japie Oosthuizen & his sons, will again host the CSMX Enduro Club.

Just 15km outside of McGregor, this venue is a favourite with many a rider, due to the long technical Gold Loop Koningsrivier riverbeds and the steep decent called "Downtown"

One of the shortest loops on the CSMX calendar, the top Gold loop riders are expected to take upwards of 50minutes to complete each lap.

Fitness will be tested on this challenging loop. Enter 200cc/Open/Seniors & Maters to follow the Gold Loop.

As is now well known, the CSMX also incorporates a easier Silver Loop. Enter Ladies/Silver/Social & 125 High School to follow the Silver Loop signage

Racing start: straight after the rider's briefing at 10am.

Race duration: Ladies/social & 125 High School ride for 2hours, and all other classes ride for 3 hours

Make certain you buy a commemorative 45 year clipper card holder, as CSMX Enduro use a clipper card system(it's like a "bus stop" on the loops, making sure you on the right loop)



Former WC Enduro Champion, Graham Hedgcock, continues with organising the future champions, by creating a more technical loop for our POP Direct backed Junior classes (65cc/85cc Juniors & the newly introduced Droomers Ladies Intro class)
