NATIONAL ENDURO SUPER SERIES (NESS)

The National Enduro Super Series (NESS) will be an overall championship, known as the NESS Power Ranking, open to E1, E2, Seniors, Masters, J1 and J2 riders where 7 of the 8 rounds(4 Enduro and 4 Extreme) will be used to calculate the best Enduro riders in South Africa.

1. Riders need to enter their National championship class (E1, E2, Seniors, Masters, J1 and J2) and if they want to compete in the NESS Power Ranking they need to enter the NESS Class under Race 2 on Race Control.
2. The NESS class will run concurrently on the day with the national championship classes to determine the overall positions on the day.
3. Where a rider entered into a class on the day that has fewer laps to complete can continue after his national championship laps are completed if they wish to do the additional laps to get a better position in the NESS Overall class.

4. For example, if a J1 rider has to complete 4 laps for the J1 championship class and E1 rider 5 laps. The J1 rider can decide to continue after his 4th lap, which will determine the J1 championship class position for the day, and then doing 5 laps for the NESS overall class position.
5. This will allow all riders across the different classes an equal opportunity to score an overall position after they have completed their national championship class requirements.
6. For any rider entering a WESS international event that clashes with any of the NESS events, they are eligible for their highest points achieved at a national Enduro or a national extreme Enduro event for their NESS Power Ranking.

17. ENTRY TO THE VENUE

Refer to MSA General Circular 6 of 2021.

The road vehicle accessing the venue will be allowed onto the event premises after successful completion of the daily screening process of all personnel in the said road vehicle. (Refer to Point 1.d. of General Circular 6 of 2021)

- To clarify, if one (1) person fails the screening process then all personnel in the affected vehicle will not be allowed entry to the premises.

An absolute minimum of team personnel is to attend per competition vehicle (motorcycle / quad):

- Maximum of five (5) persons per race vehicle (excluding rider) – Each person / crew member attending an event needs to be allocated to a rider/competitor, or be assisting at the event in an official capacity. No person can attend events as spectators due to Covid regulations.

Temperature screening will be conducted on all persons entering the venue, and any person with a recorded temperature of 37.5 degrees or higher will be denied access to the event and will be advised to return home, self-isolate and contact the Government Coronavirus hotline – 0800 029 999 – for further instructions, which may include being referred for COVID-19 testing

No entry will be granted to the event premises without the suitable documentation being completed, and in order, in advance of the event.

All event attendees permitted to be present at an event shall be required to complete the following designated COVID-19 related forms:

- Attendance Register Questionnaire = must be completed and electronically submitted to the event organisers/promoters prior to the event

- Daily Screening Questionnaire = must be completed, printed and handed to the screening personnel at the gate on each day of the event, or be submitted electronically if the event organiser/promoter had made MSA-approved prior arrangements in this regard
Under no circumstances shall anyone with symptoms consistent with Covid-19 (such as fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, fatigue or lack of sense of smell) or who tested positive for Covid-19, be permitted entry into the Motorsport event.
Under no circumstances shall anyone attend a Motorsport event if they have been: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Diagnosed with COVID-19 in the previous 14 days; or - Been in contact with a known COVID-19 positive case in the previous 14 days.

36. COVID-19 INFORMATION

Event Organisers / Promoters will ensure sanitisation of the venue that is in use for the event, before, during and after the event.

Practical measures to enforce social distancing requirements is to be put in place, including the provision of signage and the creation of barriers and/or markings that restrict the number of people in any given area.

<p>Covid-19 signage will be clearly displayed as and where appropriate to remind people present to wear masks, clean their hands and practice social distancing.</p>
